We filled the last spot with Underground Food Collective. FIBs food cart burnt down, and they are going to be in a tent this year, so please patronize them and wish them well.

Parking permits will be green for not at Olin, blue for at Olin (remember blue by the water). The WPS lot is now called the Olin Center lot since WPS hasn't been there for years. It is the Olin Center lot. Make sure everyone knows this. We will have better signs and directions will be on the back of the parking permits for the brewers to get there. This will be brewer and musician parking.

Staff shirts will be at the park Wed. The rest of the merch will go to the club space for folding and sorting.

For club potluck Friday, try to bring your own picnic ware and cups. If you want to donate silverware, plastic picnic plates, serving utensils see Erin Savaske who oversees the potluck. Bring good food. There will be food later on for those that need to do work until later.

For Friday brewer load in, if you have a cart and are not totally busy, they could use your help with carts.

If you get requests for ice, you can direct them to the ice truck, down by the boat launch and food court.

The early entry list will be sent out soon, and if you have a spouse or a person that puts up with you all year and your work for the event, they can go on this list. It is not for your friends and neighbors. Please use the early entry list wisely. The police are keenly aware that we have a large amount of people in prior to the event, and we need to respect that and not have a bunch of extra people. These early entry people do need a ticket, but if on the list can get in early. This early time is mainly for brewers to network and see other brewers. If you do have an early entry special person, please get their name on the list. Jason said he will talk to Dan Bush about how to get glassware to the volunteers that are very busy at noon. Musicians can get their glass when they check in to prevent them from going through the line twice.
